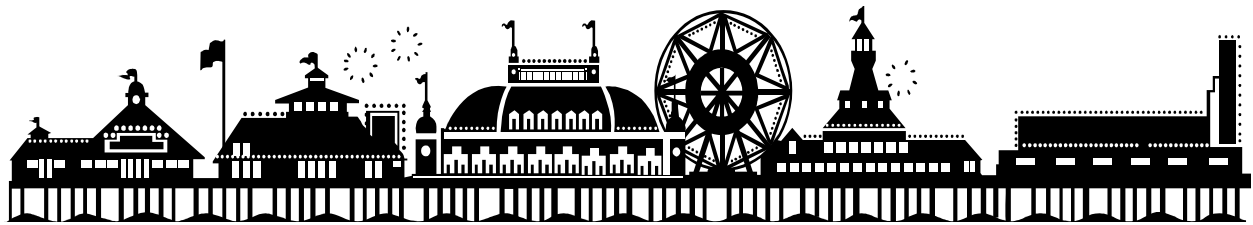

## **If choosing to become a Contestant for Miss Putnam County Fair**

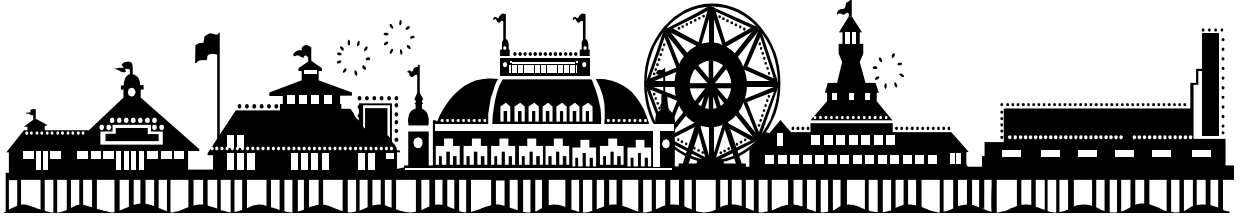
### ***General Expectations***

Although this is considered an agricultural fair pageant- it is also a beauty pageant. Let me explain what I just said: You will represent Putnam County at many events throughout the year. You need to be prepared to present yourself as if it is the evening of the pageant and the day you won – **with hair and make-up polished and applied at these events throughout the year.**

**If you aren't prepared to walk the walk and look the look you may want to reconsider entering this pageant.** If you have signed the Official Rules to be a contestant in the Miss Putnam Co. Fair Pageant, you are now a representative of the county. So therefore, please be aware that drinking, smoking, partaking in any illegal substances or behaving in an inappropriate manner will be brought to our attention and will lead to your removal from this competition.

### ***Stuff to Know***

- This is an agricultural fair. You should brush up on your knowledge of agriculture.
- You should also brush up on your knowledge of Putnam County.
- What are your responsibilities as Miss PCF if you win?
- What are your duties during the fair?
- What is happening at the Putnam County Fair this year?
- Why do you want to become the next Miss PCF?
- What can you bring to the fair that others cannot?
- If you win, you will have the opportunity to compete at the state pageant. Are you familiar with the State Queen's duties?



### ***Miscellaneous information***

- As some of your many gifts upon winning, you will receive a crown, a sash, trophy, gift award items. These items are yours to keep after your reign has ended. If any of the provided items are lost or damaged, it is your responsibility to replace these items at your own expense. Prior approval of any damaged, broken, replaceable items must be obtained from the Pageant Coordinator before replacing any items. Pageant Coordinator will reorder these for you.
- You may not go out and replace your crown and sash, because you don't like it. **If you don't like the items awarded you, you may turn them in with your title.**
- **Expenses ALL PCF Queens will be responsible for...**
- Mileage/fuel/ parking expenses for events attended throughout your reign.
- Scrapbook materials for you scrapbook during your reign. (Mandatory)
- All parade expenses (vehicle/mileage/fuel) including parade candy if you choose to throw candy.
- Camera, film, and photo processing expenses throughout the reign.
- Magnetic car signs for parades. ( Mandatory)
- Photo Queen card. ( Mandatory)
- Time to Prepare float for parade.

# *Putnam County Fair Beauty Pageant*

## **Official Rules**

- 1. Entrant must be a U.S. citizen and must be of good moral character; never been convicted of a crime, has any criminal charges pending against them, or has any adjudication pending against them. Entrants should not have engaged in any activities that are characterized as dishonest, immoral, or indecent. Entrant must have conduct becoming of a Queen at all times.**
- 2. Entrant must be a single female; never have been married, divorced, or had a marriage annulled. Entrant must have never been pregnant, nor may become pregnant or married during her reign.**
- 3. Any piercing, other than 2 ear lobe piercings, must be removed prior to pageant. If there is a navel piercing that can't be removed, a band-aid must be placed over it to tape it down.**
- 4. No visible tattoos or body art will be allowed.**
- 5. Entrant is required to attend all workshops and rehearsals.**
- 6. Entrant agrees to have the entry fee paid (whether through sponsor or parent). No refunds will be given for any reason.**
- 7. Entrant agrees the judges' decision is final.**
- 8. All grievances or objections relative to anything other than the actual contest will be referred to the Pageant Committee.**
- 9. Place all activities associated with the title of Putnam County Fair Queen, above any and all other personal appearances. Exceptions can be made with approval in advance by the Pageant Coordinator.**
- 10. We are a Local, Working, Scholarship Program. This means we expect you to show up, and work, take part in and represent at all times. (Miss Level Only) At the end of your Reign you will receive your scholarship, unless otherwise noted, by being chosen to go to state level competition**

**If chosen as a 2012 Putnam County Fair Queen in any category, the entrant agrees:**

- 1. To be available at any time during the Putnam County Fair, to serve as an official hostess of the event. A schedule will be provided to the Queen the night of the Pageant.**
- 2. Not to partake in any alcoholic beverages, smoking cigarettes, or using any illegal drugs, NO public fighting, swearing or nude photos while holding you're newly earned title. We monitor your Facebook .com accounts & etc.**
- 3. To obtain approval in advance from the Pageant Coordinator for all personal appearances, as well as any photographic sessions and pictures released as a PCF Queen.**
- 4. It is the responsibility of a parent or legal guardian of the PCF Queen to provide all transportation to and from events during the week of the Putnam County Fair and all other public appearances. "On Time" is 15 minutes early.**
- 5. Not to miss more than three (3) events, without contacting the Pageant coordinator, emergencies only will be excused! Most events will be short notice please be prepared. Communication is the key to a successful year.**
- 6. You will need to have funds made available to supply your photo business cards, monogrammed Thank-you notes, embroidered name on back of sash, and car magnets. If you are unable to supply these, sponsorship is allowed for these expenses.**
- 7. To continue community service and civic involvement. As well as personal achievement. These are second to your year full of duties.**
- 8. NO wearing two crowns. You cannot compete in another pageant during your reign. (You can compete at an approved state level, but no other.) You can move up but never sideways.**
- 9. Grade point averages are not to be lower than a 2.5. If you are having academic difficulties please get a tutor.**

10. If for any reason a Queen is unable to fulfill her duties, she is to turn in her awards immediately. We will try to reach you through phone calls, text, emails, etc. If you show up at an event after your 3 missed scheduled events, your title and awards will be taken from you immediately. (This is known as 'stripping') Your 1<sup>st</sup> runner up will be called to replace you. If you chose not to contact us and return your awards, after you have failed to meet your obligation, we will have no choice but to pursue legal actions against you. You will be responsible for the total cost of your awards.
11. Remember you willingly volunteered to compete in this pageant. Upon winning, you are responsible for attending all scheduled event, meetings, and guest appearances. If at any time it becomes too much PLEASE, resign respectfully. Saving you any unnecessary embarrassment.
12. Should you meet the requirement to represent Putnam Co. Fair at the State level, PCF will cover your entry fee and Hotel expenses. All other expenses can be sponsored; a form will be given to you with your state info packet.
13. Remember you will be a Queen representing your title for a year. Eyes will be on you. Putnam County Fair Pageants expect you to be well behaved at all times. No Public Display of Affection (PDA) Teenage queens, no boyfriends allowed while you are on duty, in crown and sash.
14. Toddlers thru Teen Miss, Parents if you have to correct your child, do so discreetly. If the Pageant Director or Staff has to correct your child it will not be discreet. Save us All the embarrassment. Best Manners and the Best Behavior AT ALL TIMES AND AT ALL EVENTS!
15. You will be given a Queens T-shirt. You are responsible for the upkeep and appearance. This is your official uniform shirt. No holes, tears, stains, or you will replace it at your expense.

**This document must be NOTARIZED. Please read the packet carefully and completely before signing below. And return with application. Any questions should be directed to the Pageant Director for clarification.**

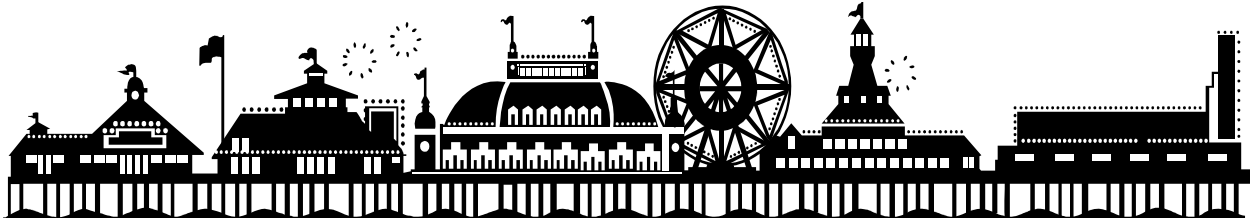
